## Description

*Provide a short description of the event and its activities.*

The project called „Cultural heritage \* Togetherness \* Equality“ responded to needs of citizens from the lead organizer Dolní Dunajovice and partner municipalities Lípa (CZ), Kunčice pod Ondřejníkem (CZ), Dechtice (SK) and Arberg (Germany). The aim of the project was to support the exchange of information between participants with an emphasis on eliminating any form of discrimination in the event venue in the municipality of Dolní Dunajovice. The personnel involved in the project aimed to present the significance and nature of the following EU policy initiatives:

- European Democracy Action Plan
- EU strategy to strengthen the application of the Charter
- Gender Equality Strategy 2020 – 2025
- EU Citizenship Report 2020

The target group of the project was characterized in accordance with the EU Charter of Fundamental Human Rights and the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. Participants of the event could take part in activities without discrimination of age, gender, nationality, religion, sexual orientation, health or social disadvantage or educational attainment. As part of the definition of the target group, their following division was made:

The primary target group was the one directly affected by the project, which was the population of the partner municipalities and adjacent regions, the Czech Republic, the Slovak Republic and Germany. The secondary target group was identified based on the impact of the project activities through changes in the primary target group.

Depending on the topics, priorities and objectives addressed, the project was in line with international institutions such as Amnesty International, European Institute for Gender Equality (EIGE), Freedom House, UNESCO and Global Rights, New European Bauhaus.

### CULTURAL HERITAGE/ Friday 21 June 2024

The first day of the event focused on educational, sporting and cognitive activities. In cooperation with the Dolní Dunajovice Primary School and the Kunčice pod Ondřejníkem Primary School, we organized sports activities, knowledge competitions and musical performances. Cognitive activities consisted of walks along the Dunajovice Hills educational trail. The first day included an introduction to the partner municipalities and a subsequent lecture on the cultural wealth of the Dolní Dunajovice region, a nation of the Czech Republic with significance for future generations. We ended the day with a presentation of wines from local wineries in South Moravia (the Czech Republic) and a session with dulcimer music.

### TOGETHERNESS/ Saturday 22 June 2024

On the second day of the event, we carried out educational activities in the form of a lecture block on the following topics:

- **Solidarity and tolerance among children, nations, and EU states**
- **Clima impacts on environment**
- **Solidarity among EU citizens**
- **Volunteering, social assistance, assistance to disadvantaged people**
- **Personality of Dr. Karl Renner**

The result of the partnership with the municipality of Arberg was the signing of a Memorandum of Cooperation. Subsequently, the implementation of activities of a folklore nature and activities for children and youth began. The event program was enriched by the ONDŘEJNÍČEK Folklore Ensemble from Kunčice pod Ondřejníkem, the female and male choirs of Dolní Dunajovice and DNS Dunajek. We supported the volunteer activity with a presentation by the Billiculum Mikulov children's daycare center with a lecture "The meaning, purpose of charitable activities in society." Subsequently, the children's program was concluded by a performance by the Myš a Maš theater group. We ended the second day of the event with evening dance entertainment.

#### **EQUALITY/ Sunday 23 June 2024**

The last day of the event was a continuation of the project's lecture activities. Participants from partner municipalities participated in a lecture block on the topics:

- **Equal rights of men and women with focus on culture, family, and job opportunities**
- **Democracy, state of law**
- **Child care, protection against consumerism**

Afterwards, a service was held in the Church of St. Giles in Dolní Dunajovice. The last day of the event continued with a concert by Kumpan's musicians, brass band and the closing of the programme for participants from partner municipalities.

The relations of the partner municipalities, through their constant communication, ensured the development of partnership relations, which are essential for further cooperation on cross-border projects. We planned the impacts of the project in such a way that they would influence the target group and the general public in the future as well. The sustainability of the project is influenced by the existence and development of partnership relations between local governments. The project outputs are owned by each partner municipality, with a focus on strengthening the sense of belonging, raising awareness of the importance of strengthening the European integration process based on solidarity, volunteering and charitable activities. The added value of the project in terms of disseminating the results among citizens consisted in raising awareness of the richness of the cultural and linguistic environment in Europe, supporting gender equality and environmental protection.
